Purpose & Background

The three Tribal LASER TLC Sites (Chippewa Cree Tribe of the Rocky Boys Reservation, the Scotts Valley Band of Pomo Indians, and the Yurok Tribe) comprise the Tribal Affinity Group. All three tribes have expressed an interest to meet with their LASER TLC tribal colleagues to discuss common issues. Site team leaders, coaches and liaisons identified topics they want to discuss, and the site team leaders prioritized the topics. Based on the level of interest in holding the session, the number of topics the tribes want to discuss, and the amount of time devoted to each session, the intent is to hold a 3-part series of **Tribal Learning Huddles** through the summer and early fall.
