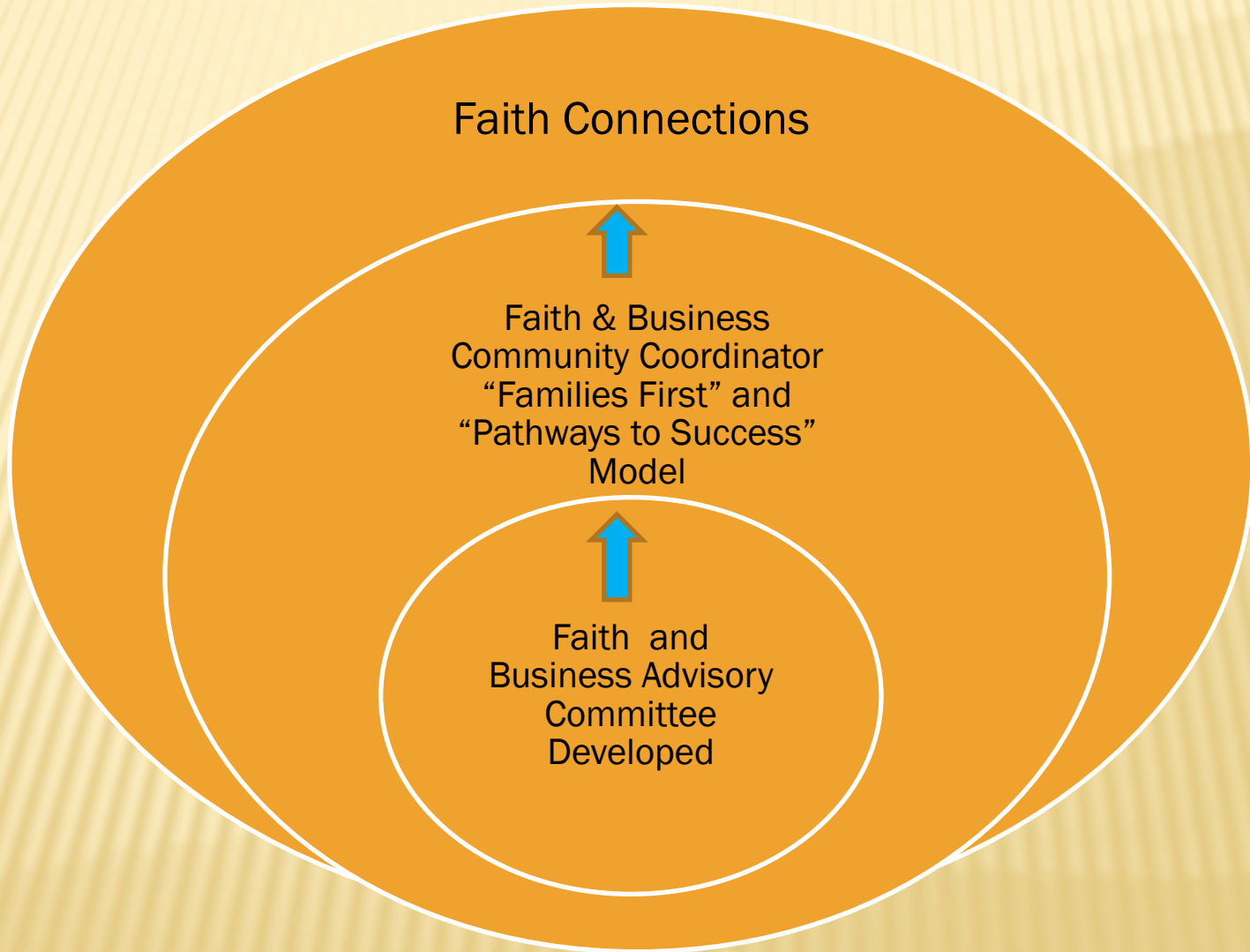

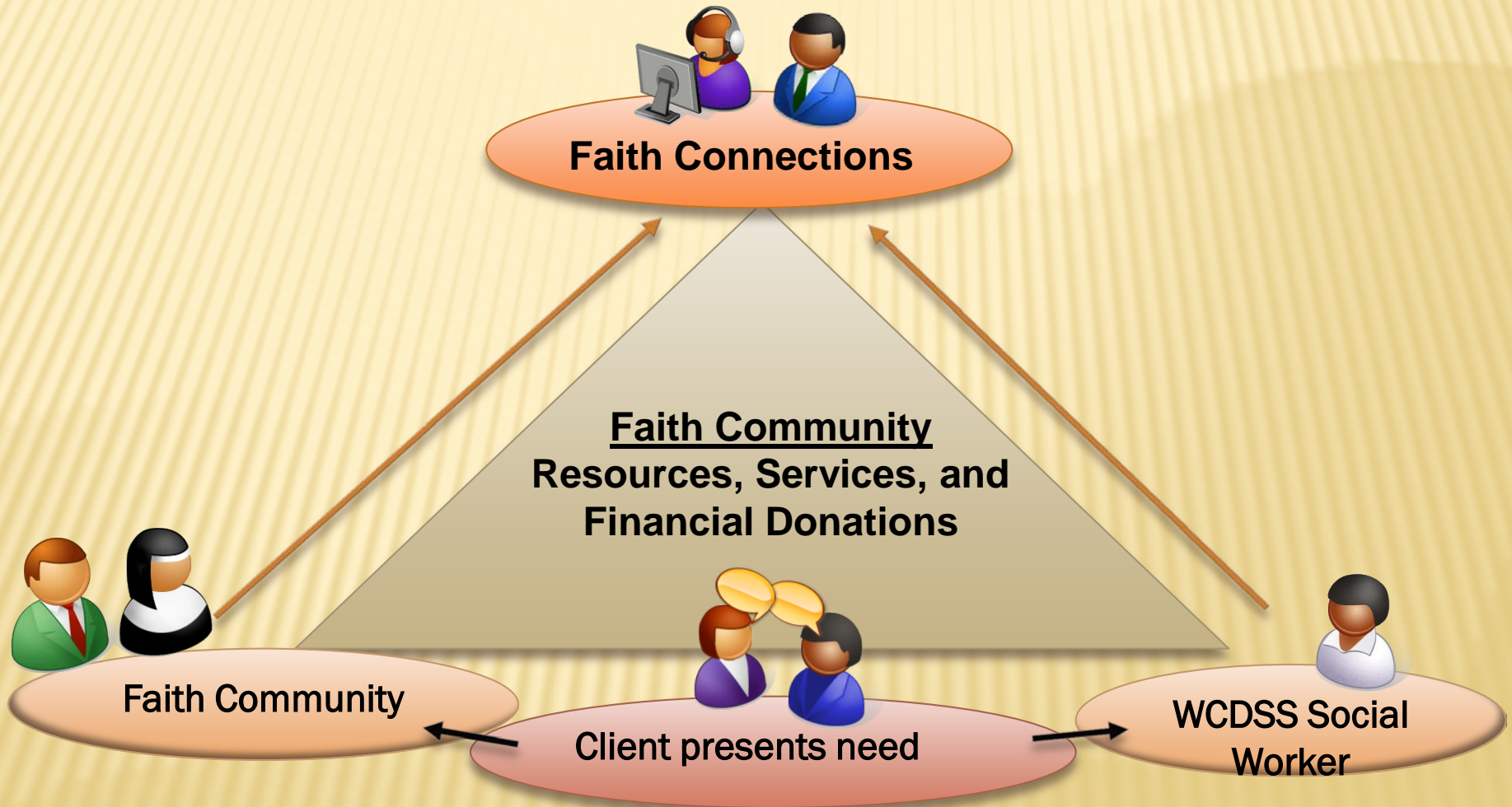

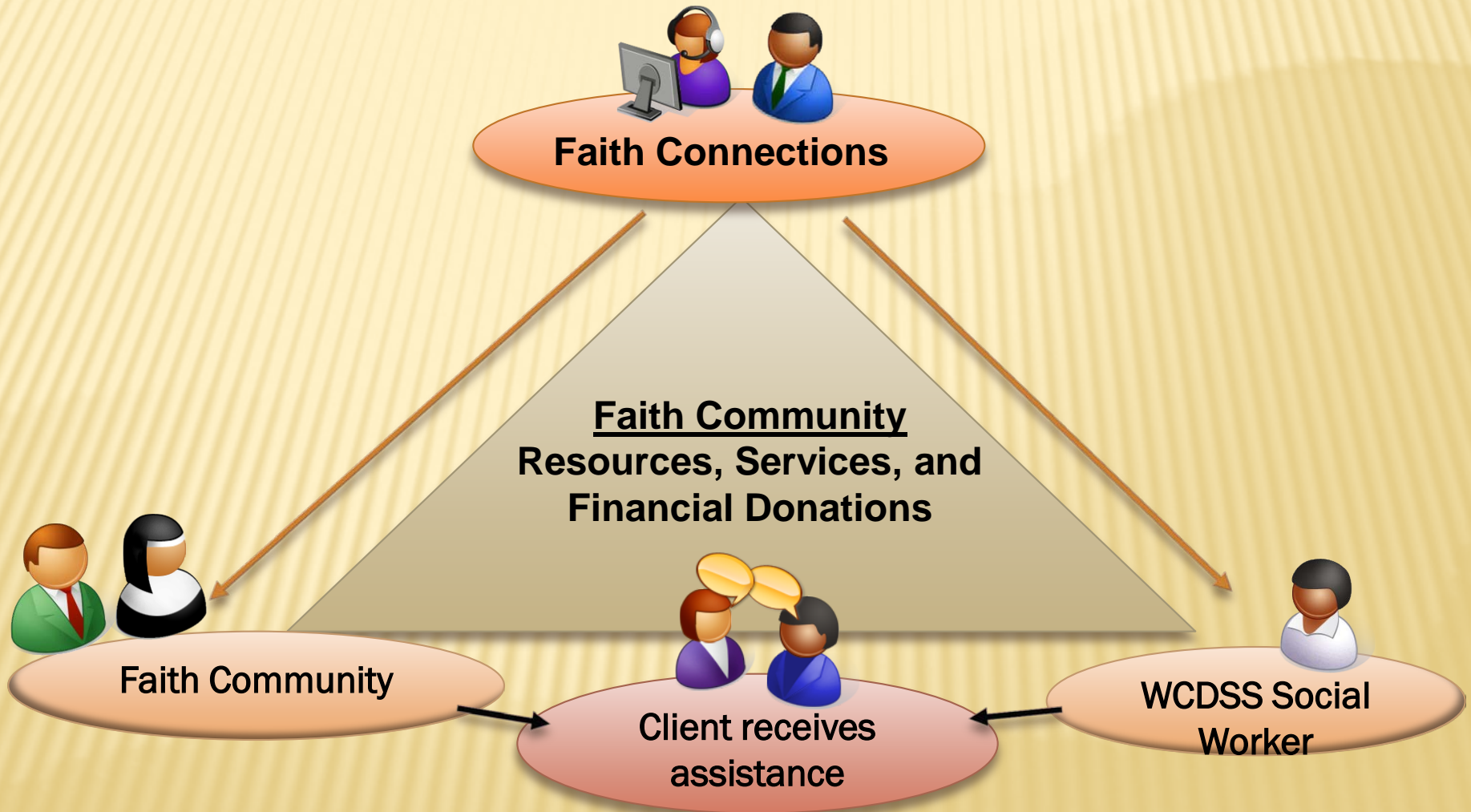
FAITH CONNECTION'S EVOLUTION



Faith Connections Process

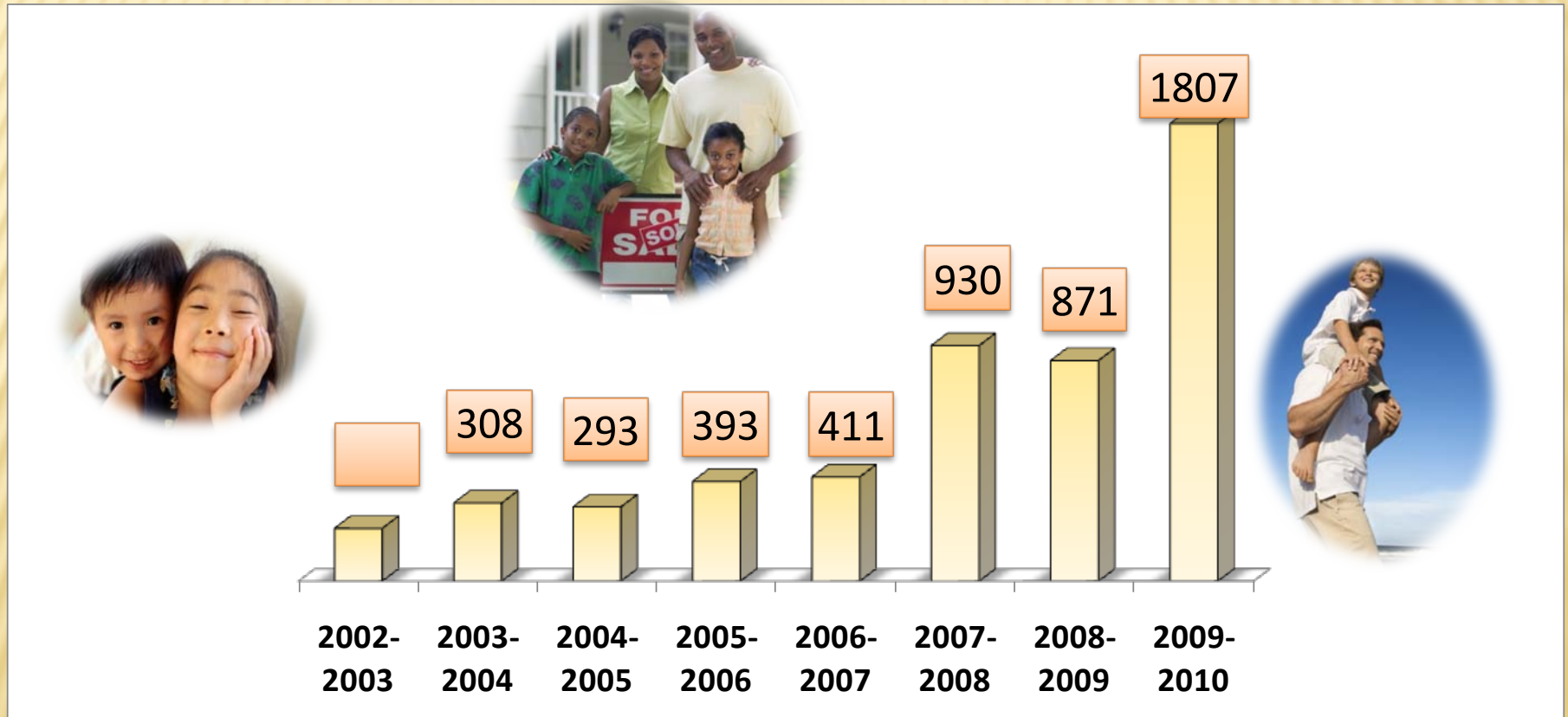


Faith Connections Outcomes



Faith Connections Growth

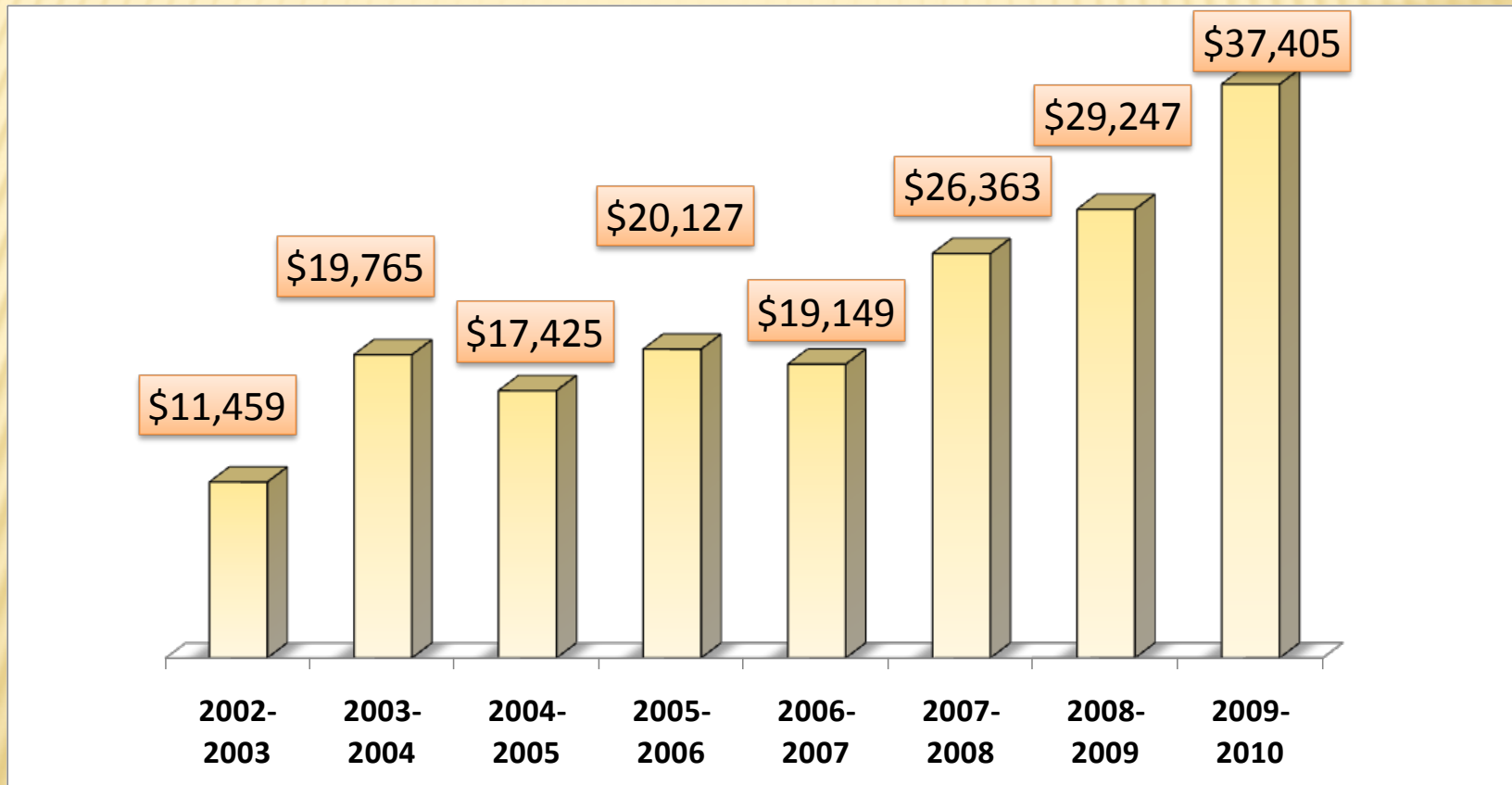
2002-2010

Program Highlights

- ✓ 70+ Partnering churches & non-profits (as of 3/1/2010 & continues to grow)
- ✓ Enhanced communication and awareness of programs and services offered
- ✓ Maximized local, state, and federal resources and funding
- ✓ Partnership with New Christian Food Pantry & Child Development Center and international hunger relief organization – bring food to greater Wilson area
- ✓ Increased growth of faith community program ministries as a result of Faith Connections

Program Funding

- ✓ Building donated to Wilson Area Community Ministries (Wilson Interfaith, Inc.) and sub-leased to DSS.
- ✓ Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) through Department of Commerce for purpose of renovating building for housing faith coordination services and asset building opportunities for Work First families.
- ✓ TANF funds used for maintaining building usage.
- ✓ Faith Coordinator's salary paid from combination of TANF and County funding.
- ✓ Financial donations received from churches go 100% for direct client financial assistance.

Partners In Ministry

Are in control

- ✓ Partners agree to allow use of name
- ✓ Partners decide what resource to provide: Monetary, Ministry or both
- ✓ Partners determine contact person and communicate with staff
