TOTAL Project Goals and Objectives

1. To deliver training and technical assistance (TTA) to state TANF programs and partners responding to the Fiscal Responsibility Act of 2023 (FRA).

- 2. Support all state and territory TANF programs and 5 pilot states by:
 - a. identifying promising approaches to collect and report data;
 - b. facilitating peer engagement;
 - c. linking states with subject matter experts;
 - d. piloting new strategies; and
 - e. providing tools and expertise for state planning and implementation activities.



Work and Education Outcomes TTA Goals and Objectives



1. Consider each states' capacity for collecting and reporting data to ensure we meet states where they are



2. Build state capacity to collect and report data




3. Develop checklists, tips, resources and tools to facilitate state data collection and reporting efforts



4. Provide states with guidance on how to use program data to improve program outcomes

Work Outcomes Measures



THREE MEASURES

- 1. Employment rate 2nd quarter after exit
- 2. Employment retention rate 4th quarter after exit
- 3. Median earnings 2nd quarter after exit






NOTES:

- ACF calculating the measures for the states based on the <u>entire universe or population</u> of work eligible individuals who left TANF each quarter
- Mandatory for all states and territories
- Due quarterly with first report due May 15, 2025



Education Outcomes Reporting







ONE MEASURE

Secondary school diploma or its recognized equivalent attainment rate





While on TANF, the individual is in at least one reporting month, simultaneously

- <24 years old
- Enrolled in secondary school, GED or equivalent
- Classified as work-eligible





NOTES:

- Calculation uses all eligible individuals in the universe or population
- Due annually with first due November 14, 2027
